DESCRIPTION OF MINISTRY
OPPORTUNITIES



Outreach and Hospitality

- 1** **Take 5 Campaign** Our first line of Evangelism during special seasons and events. Participants are encouraged to take 5 door hangers (provided by the church), 5 minutes, and hang them on 5 of their neighbor's doors, inviting them to our Church's ministries or special event.
- 2** **Good Neighbor Outreach** Each month we receive a list of names and addresses of people who have moved into Texas City. Our good neighbor outreach program involves members taking these lists and finding who has moved into their neighborhood and welcoming them.
- 3** **Welcome Team Ministry** The Welcome Team would identify visitors on a Sunday Morning and present themselves to answer questions and make sure the visitors are comfortable in our worship. If possible, the Welcome Team member would offer to sit with a visitor to help them through the service. After worship, the Welcome Team member in ministry would introduce the visitor to the Pastor or other leaders of the church.
- 4** **Call Visitors** This is a ministry that can be done from the comfort of your own home. Each week, as visitors leave their phone numbers, these members would call to thank them for attending as well as attempt to answer questions about the church. They would also be helpful in calling past visitors who may not have attended in awhile and let them know they have been missed.
- 5** **Bake Bread For Visitors** Weekly bake bread, as needed, for giving out to our visitors.
- 6** **Bread Delivery To Visitors** To take the freshly baked bread provided to 2nd time visitors of our church. This would be a home delivery, but the member would not be asked to enter the visitor's home.

Congregational Care

- 7** **Bereavement Meals** Help to cook, serve, and/or clean up meals made for families that have recently lost loved ones. This is a servant hearted ministry, showing love to a family while representing our church. These meals are usually provided at the church, but delivery is sometimes done, as well. (serving and clean up are not done off-site)

- 8 **Grief Support Group** Members helping members recover from the loss of a spouse, child, or other family member. This could be one-on-one or a group meeting at a set time.
- 9 **Cards To Homebound & Hospitalized** Making, purchasing, or organizing cards sent to the Homebound and those in the hospital. This ministry is done individually in the name of the church and can have several people working separately on it. It is always nice to receive several cards!
- 10 **Prayer Email** Agree to email or call known prayer requests to the church. This also will include a prayer email that will be sent out as needed asking these same members to pray for specific needs.
- 11 **Thursday Morning Prayer Group** A small group that comes together at 9:30am every Thursday in the church parlor to pray over the needs of our members and their friends/ co-workers.
- 12 **Nursing Home Visitation** Visit one on one with a member in the nursing home. This can be done weekly or monthly.
- 13 **Homebound Friends** Visit one on one with a member who is no longer able to attend church or leave their home without assistance. This can be done weekly or monthly, over the phone or in person.
- 14 **Homebound Communion Steward** Take communion once a month to our church's homebounds who have requested communion. This happens on the first Sunday of each month as well as special times of the year.
- 15 **Hospital Visitation** Visit members of our church in the hospital, especially in times of long term stay. The office of the church would notify when someone needs a visit.
- 16 **Membership Shepherds** Shepherds have two jobs... to help new members find a place to do ministry within the church, and to help members who have not attended the church in awhile find a place to belong. The hope is to guide these new members and old members, alike, into active ministry with the church through our love, showing that we care for them.

Pictorial Directory / Ministry Magazine

- 17 **Membership Contact** This member in ministry would help coordinate the next pictorial directory by contacting members and getting them signed up for specific dates.

- 18 **Hospitality** This member in ministry would help coordinate the next pictorial directory by helping provide drinks, cookies, etc in a sitting room for waiting families during the time of the picture shoot.
- 19 **Check-In** This member in ministry would help coordinate the next pictorial directory by greeting people on the day of shooting, and verifying people's contact information.

International Ministries

- 20 **Serve on a Global Mission Work Team** Leave the country on an organized and UM sponsored mission trip. This would be to help other impoverished nations/ people and would most likely be a longer than normal time spent away from the states.
- 21 **Nothing But Nets Volunteer** Help in organizing and publicizing our church's involvement in the Nothing But Nets national campaign. NBN raises money to purchase insecticide treated bed nets to stop the spread of Malaria in Africa.
- 22 **Help Fundraise for Mission Teams from FUMC** Helping people takes money, and we need help in raising that money. Sometimes it takes more people than just the people participating in the missions. If you want to help, but can't commit to a long term trip, you can help fundraise to send someone from our church to help others.
- 23 **Support Missions Financially** We need some people to support missions on a more personal basis. If you are interested in supporting a missionary traveling to another country, or a group traveling to another country, on a more one on one basis, we could use you.

National / State / Local Ministries

- 24 **UM ARMY Adult Volunteer** Sweat, blood, tears, and a little elbow grease go along with helping our Youth help others in need. Spend a week (Sunday through Saturday) of your summer going on this mission trip with our Sr. High Youth.
- 25 **Summit Adult Volunteer** If a week seems a little long, come on this trip. (Wednesday through Saturday) Spend a few days with the Jr. High helping others on this mission trip.
- 26 **Helping Hands** Helping Hands is a mission opportunity to provide small home repairs, painting, and yard work for members in need at our church. Group gets together on Saturdays, usually once a month. Members are contacted by email or by phone for the next month's project.

- 27 **Serve on a Mission Work Team** Through the United Methodist Church, there are always opportunities to go and serve somewhere in the U.S. If you love mission work and can help, there is always something available.
- 28 **Disaster Response Team (Local)** With the threat of hurricanes, tornados, flash floods, and even the chemical plant, we need a group of people who are first responders that can help our community recover after a natural or man-made Disaster. These members will be called on to be creative in their responses... ideas could range from clothing drives to cooking meals for our neighborhood.
- 29 **Disaster Response Team (Regional)** This group would send teams of people to our neighbors and provide help after a major disaster. Tools could be necessary, or even just a helping hand.
- 30 **UMCOR** This stands for United Methodist Committee On Relief. It is a National/International group that provides relief to areas that really need assistance. UMCOR does a national call several times a year for supplies to stock up on and send during a national disaster. Signing up to help UMCOR could mean helping to assemble anything from flood buckets to food staple boxes.
- 31 **Serve on FUMC Mission Committee** Our Missions Committee oversees all of our Missions and Mission teams. They oversee all fundraising and are in charge of what teams go where, and how mission money is spent.

Community Ministries

- 32 **Community Activities Team** This Team coordinates all ministries that are community action oriented. Team members oversee and lead all parts of their projects and attempt to involve other members of the church in the ministry.
- 33 **Blood Drive Donor** If you are 17 years or older, we need your blood. Area Blood Banks are always in need of blood and plasma donations.
- 34 **Blood Drive Volunteer** Help organize the drives, and schedule people for appointments to give blood. These members would organize all levels of hosting a blood drive.
- 35 **Stroke Prevention Plus Volunteer** These people help to organize the screenings and help to schedule people to get the screenings. They also help out during the process, greeting people on behalf of our church and helping them find where to go.

- 36 **Feeding the Homeless** Every 3rd Saturday members of our church come together to make and serve food to some people who really could use a hot meal. If you can cook a little or a lot, and enjoy serving others, this would be a wonderful ministry for you. Currently we would also be looking for someone to direct or head up this ministry, as well. Please make a note if your heart yearns to help others.
- 37 **Aid & Assistance Ministry** A number of the non-profits in town that help those who are destitute are not immediate in their help. This ministry is a way to help to raise money and organize the distribution of it to people who are in an emergency.
- 38 **Habitat for Humanity** This is an old and well established program that helps to build Low Cost Housing for people who would normally never believe they could own their own home.
- 39 **FUMC Food Pantry** These people organize and restock our small store of non-perishable food that we give out to people when they come to the church asking for it.
- 40 **Mainland Food Bank** We need people to help collect and deliver food for the MFB. This ministry would help not only plan food drives, but also make sure the correct agencies received it.
- 41 **Gleanings from the Harvest** Gleanings From The Harvest for Texas City is an Interfaith, community based organization, established solely to receive surplus food from restaurants, grocery stores, institutions that prepare meals, corporations that manufacture food products, food brokers and shippers. Members in ministry would help their day to day operations by volunteering once a week, or once a month.

Worship Ministries

- 42 **Parking Lot Attendants** These wonderful helpers direct traffic around the church and in the parking lot. They also provide a free valet service to some members who have a hard time walking all the way to the parking lot.
- 43 **Worship Assistant** A worship assistant fills various roles in the worship service by helping (usually at the last minute, but sometimes planned) on special events, doing readings during seasonal services, etc. There are not a specific number of times during the year that these members would help, but instead would be “on call”.
- 44 **Liturgist** The liturgist helps with the worship by reading announcements, scripture, and the call to worship during the worship service. Usually a liturgist helps between 3 and 5 times a year.

- 45 **Help Serve Communion** Communion servers help to administer the bread and grape juice on Communion Sundays. (First Sunday of each month, as well as seasonal services)
- 46 **Greeters – Visitor Welcome** Greet people as they come in and pass out bulletins before service.
- 47 **Children’s Time Leader** A Children’s Time Leader creates and delivers a special 2-6 minute oral message for the Children during worship.
- 48 **Children’s Time Supporter** Kids are a handful. While the message is being given, some people are needed to help corral the kiddos and keep them attentive to the leader. After the children’s message, these supporters assist in taking the children to the nursery.
- 49 **Ushers** Dealing with several different jobs, the Ushers will help to distribute bulletins with the Greeters, they assist people in being seated if needed, they collect the offering during the service, and they straighten up the sanctuary after the worship is over. Collect registration sheet and put them in the office.
- 50 **Operate Sound System
(10:30am)** Can you run a sound system? We need people to run the new sound system during the 10:30 worship service. This position would be as an assistant to learn how everything is done, so that scheduling can happen.
- 51 **Operate Sound System
(Special Events)** See above. This is for irregularly scheduled events.
- 52 **Operate Camera / Video** These members in ministry would film the worship services.
- 53 **Operate Camera / Video
(Special Events)** See above. This is for irregularly scheduled events.
- 54 **Operate Multimedia
(10:30am)** If you can operate a computer, you can be trained to operate the multimedia in the church worship service. This member in ministry would use the projectors, EasyWorship, and direct the cameras.
- 55 **Altar Guild** The Altar Guild is a group that takes care of the chancel area of the sanctuary. This includes but is not limited to, changing the liturgical banners, keeping them orderly, creating new ones, and hanging banners.
- 56 **Sanctuary Stewards** These members make sure the sanctuary is well cared for. They clean and polish the pews yearly, and setup seasonal things like the Christmas tree. On a weekly basis, they would make sure attendance pads are filled, along with prayer request cards, and info on the church.

- 57 **Set Up/Take Down Equipment** During the seasons of the Christian calendar year, there are always special events that happen. We need dedicated members to help set up for these services and events, as well as to help break them down.

Music Ministries

- 58 **Chancel Choir** Whether you are on key or off key, the choir would love for you to come and make that “joyful noise” with them. They meet every Wednesday night at 7pm.
- 59 **Handbell Choir** The Handbell Choir meets weekly, Wednesday’s at 6pm in the sanctuary for training and practice. Even if you have never read a single note of music before, they are able to teach anyone to ring the bell like a professional. All ages are welcome!
- 60 **Musician:** Do you have an instrument you would like to come and play during a worship service or other special event? List (Instrument)_____ it here and we would love to include you.
- 61 **Vocalist / Soloist** Special and Seasonal events, as well as normal Sundays are all blessed by people using their talents for singing. If you would like to perform during one of our worship services, we would love to have you.

Spiritual Growth Ministries

- 62 **Short Term Bible Study Leaders (Morning)** Do you like to teach or even facilitate bible studies? Do you enjoy learning from your students sometimes more than you end up teaching them? Then you might sign up to be a bible study leader! Curriculum is provided for our studies which are offered at different times of the year.
- 63 **Short Term Bible Study Leaders (Evening)** Do you like to teach or even facilitate bible studies? Do you enjoy learning from your students sometimes more than you end up teaching them? Then you might sign up to be a bible study leader! Curriculum is provided for our studies which are offered at different times of the year.
- 64 **Long Term Bible Study Leader (Morning)** Do you like to teach or even facilitate bible studies? Do you enjoy learning from your students sometimes more than you end up teaching them? Then you might sign up to be a bible study leader! Curriculum is provided for our studies which are offered at different times of the year.
- 65 **Long Term Bible Study Leader (Evening)** Do you like to teach or even facilitate bible studies? Do you enjoy learning from your students sometimes more than you end up teaching them? Then you might sign up to be a bible study leader! Curriculum is provided for our studies which are offered at different times of the year.

- 66 **Sunday Bible Class Teachers** Do you like to teach Sunday morning Bible Classes? Teachers are needed to lead adult Sunday School classes for a one month period. Curriculum is provided.
- 67 **Substitute Teachers - Sunday Morning** Maybe you do not want to teach for a solid month, but would not mind stepping in for a single Sunday every now and then. Well, you are for sure wanted and needed! Sign up if you would like to help substitute teach in an adult Sunday School class (bible class).
- 68 **United Methodist Women's Ministry** The United Methodist Women are a community of women whose purpose is to know God and to experience freedom as whole persons through Jesus Christ. They have a creative supportive fellowship and seek to expand concepts of mission through participation in the global ministries of the church.

Youth Ministries (Grades 6th – 12th)

- 69 **Bible Study Teacher** Are you a biblical scholar? Or not so much? Relevance can still use you to help teach the Dogma Sr. High bible study on a rotational basis. Curriculum is provided.
- 70 **Help Teach Confirmation Class** The Confirmation class needs people to teach the provided curriculum. Teachers would rotate once a month.
- 71 **Mentor For Confirmation Class** Each confirmand needs someone to help guide them through the Confirmation process. Mentors provide each student with support and guidance. A mentor does not need special training, but instead needs to be mature in their faith and interested in supporting a young person's growth and learning.
- 72 **Prayer Project** In the prayer project, each person receives a card with the name of one of the Students on it. This person is asked to pray daily for the student named on their card. Through this project we cover our youth with prayer.
- 73 **Transportation In Personal Vehicle – Local** Drivers are always needed!. People who don't mind driving a bunch of Youth around. These would be day trips and are 1-2 times a month. (gas is reimbursed)
- 74 **Transportation In Personal Vehicle – Trip** These are people who don't mind spending some time with some really cool students. We need folks to provide transportation for, and attend, overnight trips. (gas is reimbursed)
- 75 **Attend Lakeview Summer Camp** This is our biggest summer trip. It is one of the most rewarding things you can do with youth. People are needed for a week long trip (Sunday-Friday).

- 76 **Youth Sunday School Teacher** Sunday school teachers teach the provided curriculum for increments of one month at a time. They also help to choose the curriculum that will be taught.
- 77 **Substitute Youth Sunday School Teacher** If a Sunday school teacher is not going to be there on a particular Sunday, substitutes fill in for them. This usually occurs 4 or 5 times a year. Curriculum can be provided.

Tuesday Night

- 78 **Food** We need people to serve the food that is provided on Tuesday nights. We also need people to pick up the pizza from CiCis. These folks will serve food for a month, then pick up pizza for a month then get some time off. (once a week for a month)
- 79 **Adult Leader** This is the most fun job. Just be there to hang out with the kids. Participate in worship and hang out time. This is a steady commitment. We would need you there every Tues. for six month increments. (time off for good behavior does apply!)

Children's Ministries

Vacation Bible School

(One Week Commitment: Sunday-Friday each night from 5:00pm – 8:30pm)

- 80 **Music Leader** Are you a singer of silly songs? Help lead the music for a week at VBS.
- 81 **Prepare Food** We need people to help in the kitchen and to serve food during VBS. This also involves cleaning up the kitchen and surrounding area afterward.
- 82 **Crafts** Help lead the kids in creating wonderful crafts each night of VBS.
- 83 **Small Group Leader** Can you wrangle a crew of children, take them to some activities, and lead them in different activities? (VBS)
- 84 **Recreation Team** Do you like silly games? We want you to facilitate and participate with the kids in some crazy activities during VBS.
- 85 **Drama** No Shakespeare's required. Perform in all the skits during VBS.
- 86 **Nursery** We need some people to help out in the nursery during VBS. If you like babies, this is for you.

- 87 **Registration** We are not able to do VBS without these members in ministry. Help to get kids checked in before VBS starts each night, and checked out after it ends each night.

Sunday Morning Classes

- 88 **Small Group Leader** Help lead a group of kids on Sunday mornings in their activities. (Grades K-5) This ministry would not involve in pre-planning or preparation. Instead it is meant to be a relationship position, getting to know the children and help them in each of the classroom workshops.
- 89 **Monthly Teacher** We need members to help teach and lead monthly workshops for our children on Sunday mornings. (Grade K-5) These classes, or workshops, would be prepared for a solid month and built around a single theme.

Nursery / Babysitting

- 90 **10:30am Nursery Worker
Once Per Month** Helpers in the nursery on Sundays during Worship play with the little ones and provide care during the church service. (5yrs and under) Safe Sanctuary training is necessary.
- 91 **Substitute Small Group Leader** These teachers step in when a Small Group Leader can't be there on a particular Sunday.
- 92 **Substitute Monthly Teacher** If a Sunday school teacher can't be there on a particular Sunday, these folks fill in.
- 93 **Sunday Morning Sunday School** These people lead the children in their Sunday School activities. (5yrs and under) This is a monthly commitment.
- 94 **Weekday Night** Sometimes during the week we need people to help look after some little ones during meetings and other functions. (Once a month)
- 95 **Weekend (Special Event)** During Special Events that happen at the church, people are needed to take care of children while their parents are doing other work. (Once a month)

Family & Fellowship Ministries

- 96 **Annual Picnic** Members help to plan and implement the Annual Church wide Picnic. They organize food, games, and the annual dessert contest.
- 97 **Easter Egg Hunt** The Easter Egg Hunt for the Children of the church is run by members who plan and put the event together.

- 98 **Fall Festival** Every Fall, there is a Festival for the entire church. Members are needed to help secure booths for vendors, to provide games for the children, and to serve food.
- 99 **Green Festival** Every Spring our CDO department, in conjunction with our Children's department, Puts together an event with games, crafts, and food. Volunteers are needed to help run this event.
- 100 **FUMC Farmers Market - Supply Produce** During Green Fest and the Spring months, member would grow produce (tomatoes, peppers, cucumbers, lemons, grapefruit, etc.) and bring them to church and share and/or swap with other members.
- 101 **Spring Craft Show** Part of Green Fest, we need people to secure booths for vendors and serve food.
- 102 **Family Christmas Party with Santa** Members are needed to provide food, fun, and someone might get to play the Jolly Old Elf himself.
- 103 **Setup for Family/Fellowship Event** In the course of getting ready for any event, strong arms are needed to help move tables, chairs, and to decorate. Please sign up if you can give just a few hours a year to helping make our events a success!
- 104 **Cleanup after Family/Fellowship Event** Yes, the part that most people avoid like the plague! But hey! Maybe YOU are one of 'those' kind who really enjoy the fellowship that goes with helping clean up after a successful event. If so, sign up and let us know that you have elbow grease to spare!
- 105 **Sunday Morning Coffee / Juice** Church is early, and some people need their coffee. These members get here a little bit before everyone else and "put the coffee on".

Administrative Ministries

- 106 **Office Angels** Office Angels come once a week during the day and help the staff to perform its duties better. Answering the phone, making phone-calls, helping with the newsletter and bulletin, and greeting people when they come into the office are just a few of the things they do.
- 107 **Bulletin Board / Signage Ministry** These members help keep everyone informed about what's going on in the church, by keeping the bulletin boards up to date. They also make sure that the Signs in and around the church look good and are informative.

Facilities Steward Ministries

- 108** **Kitchen Angel** No church is complete without a kitchen, and no kitchen is complete without a kitchen angel. These members make sure that the kitchen is orderly for our events. They also take inventory, making sure the kitchen is well stocked with supplies.
- 109** **Event Liaison Coordinators** When there are special events that take place at the church that are not church sponsored (such as weddings, birthday parties, etc), these members open up the church, assist the people putting on the event with facility needs, adjust heaters/AC and lock up after the event.
- 110** **Building Attendant** These members open up the church, turn on the A/C, and help get things ready on Sundays, and for other church events. They also lock up after church events.
- 111** **Parsonage Care Committee** This group of members helps to look after the church Parsonage by working with the current pastor to assess and address the needs of the home. The parsonage committee is always trying to improve the current parsonage, making it up to date and ready for the minister's family to occupy.
- 112** **Electrical** These members help to take care of the electrical needs of the church. This could be small repairs, or overseeing the use of a professional electrician.
- 113** **Plumbing** These members help to take care of the plumbing needs of the church. This could be small repairs, or overseeing the use of a professional plumber.
- 114** **Carpentry** These members help to take care of the architectural needs of the church. This could be small repairs, or overseeing the use of a professional carpenter or dry-waller. As small as repairing older wooden furniture, up to building mailboxes for the staff.
- 115** **Mechanical** These members help to take care of the equipment around the church. This could be small to large repairs, or overseeing a repairman, and even overseeing the purchase of new equipment.
- 116** **A/C & Heating – Upkeep & Small Maintenance** These members help to take care of the church air conditioner. Changing filters, patching ductwork, and cleaning vents are things these members do.
- 117** **A/C & Heating – Repair** These members do full repairs to the A/C system, and help oversee the purchase, and installation of equipment.

- 118** **Welding Projects** These members help to build metal projects around the church. This could be small repairs, to all out fabrications.
- 119** **Painting – Small Scale Project** We need members to help with one day painting projects, like Sunday school class rooms and offices, or even just touch ups on walls.
- 120** **Painting – Large Scale Project** We need members to help with longer/larger projects like the outside of the buildings, the sanctuary, and sometimes to oversee professional painters.
- 121** **Lawn Care** Beyond trees and flowerbeds, the yard /grass takes a lot of care. If you enjoy cutting grass, aerating the grass, and fertilizing the grass, then have we got a deal for you! Lots of lawn! Lots of Green! All for you!
- 122** **Tree Trimming** Our oaks and trees are beautiful, but they take some tender loving care. This ministry would seasonally make sure our trees are trimmed out to be as attractive as possible. Chainsaw and ladder will be needed!
- 123** **Landscaping** Some many possibilities for flowers, flower beds, plantings, and ornamental trees! Our huge campus would love to have you and your green thumb give it that special touch. If you love to work in the garden, or even make new ones, this is a chance to let your creative juices flow!
- 124** **Custodial Care** No matter how much we plan ahead, there are always spots and places in our facilities that need that once a year elbow grease applied. This ministry would operate year round, identifying new cleaning projects, and organizing a work force to scrub! scrub! scrub!
- 125** **Minor Repairs** Invariably there are things around the church that need to be repaired and do not fall under any specific category. If you are a handyman or handywoman who enjoys doing odds and ends repairs, let us know of your special abilities!
- 126** **Preventative Maintenance** Help to take care of our facilities by changing out basic items in the church. (filters/light bulbs/etc.)

Ministry Boards

- 127** **Children's Day Out (CDO)** CDO Advisory and Ministry board helps to guide our CDO in its day to day operations as well as set its goals for the future.
- 128** **Memorial Ministries** Currently known as the Memorial Committee, they meet bi-monthly or as needed to decide how to best help other ministries of the church by dedicating finances toward

these projects. Memorials are given in honor of, or in memory of, members of our church and their families.

- 129 Children's Ministry** Our burgeoning children's ministry board would help the Children's Director with curriculum, special projects, programs, events, and fundraisers.

Every Member In Ministry Team (EMIM)

- 130 Attend EMIM Training In Alabama** A new way of doing stewardship: if you are interested in going to be trained at Frazer Memorial UMC you will not be disappointed! It is an amazing weekend that will energize you to come back and find ways to help others become a member in ministry!
- 131 Deliver Packets** After the kick off Sunday, any packets that were not picked up by individuals or families will need to be hand delivered to their doorstep. Members helping to deliver these packets will help save the church on postage as well as get a chance to meet a fellow member face to face. Relationships are always important!
- 132 EMIM Administrator** This person will be in charge of making sure that all of the compiled information after EMIM is given to the correct ministry leaders. This person is also responsible for making sure that the ministry leaders use that information.
- 133 EMIM Organizer** This group helps to put together the packets that are sent out and hand delivered. Each packet is personalized for each household, so quite a bit of work goes into making the packets.
- 134 Setup for Consecration Sunday** Consecration Sunday is our celebration of all of the commitments that our members have made for the next year. It is a wonderful time to come, eat and fellowship together. We need organizers who will help this great event get off the ground.
- 135 Cleanup after Consecration Meal** And when the event is over, we need dedicated members who will make sure that our facilities and kitchen are ready to do ministry again by helping to clean up. If you love to clean and make things look spic and span, here is your chance!

Drama Ministries
